  - Verification of free or reduced lunch eligibility. You can request proof of free or reduced lunch through your child's school by calling the SBAC's Food Service Office at 352-955-7539, extension 1569. Ask that the letter be emailed to you and EarthAcademy@cityofgainesville.org

- 3) Register for camp starting 9am, March 1st online or in person at Thomas Center B, 3rd floor. Use your coupon to receive the awarded discount.
